### WHY CHOICES?

The Buffalo Urban League wanted to help teens make the right choice about their education, job, and life decisions. The group felt CHOICES gave students hands-on activities that provided students a better understanding about making choices that will affect them later on in life.

The program has been funded through grants and has already impacted 240 students.

### RESULTS:

- Number of Years CHOICES delivered: 2
- Number of Classes Served per Year: 6 (150 Students\*)
- Number of Schools Served per Year: 2
- Number of Active Presenters: 1
